## CURBSIDE CART & DROP SITE FRIENDLY ITEMS

### CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD

**Flatten**, remove plastic & foam.  
Tape & Labels OK.



### CARTONS

Coated paperboard that held liquid. **Rinse & keep cap on.**



### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

Clean & empty. Labels OK. **Remove metal lids.**



### PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS & TUBS

Rigid plastics only. NO FOAM. Labels OK.  
**#1-7. Rinse & keep cap on.**



### PAPER, MAGAZINES, & NEWSPAPER

Remove plastic & rubber bands.  
**No shredded paper**



### METAL CANS & FOIL

CLEAN & empty. Labels OK.  
**Aerosol cans MUST be empty!**



### NOT ACCEPTED:

Plastic bags, shredded paper, cords/cables/wires, electronics, hazardous materials, windows, gift wrap, Styrofoam, clothing



- Open 8:00AM - 3:30PM on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month. This site is closed January and February.
- Accepted: electronics, tv/monitor (\$3 fee), polystyrene, tires, appliances, metal, & co-mingled/single stream
- Bulky trash disposal option for a fee
